Dear Members,

How can we be the change we want to see in the world?

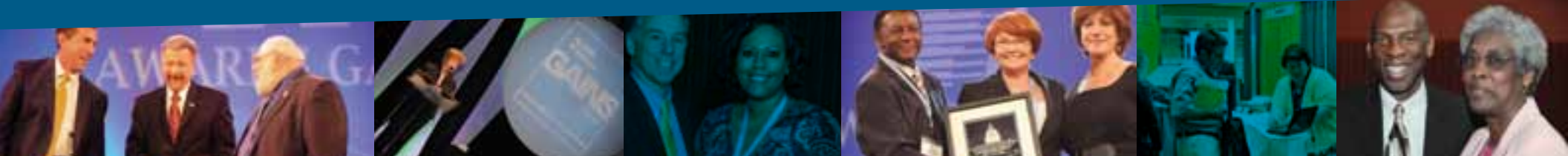
In 2010, that was the big question.

We answered it as we answer every challenge: by coming together, armed with devotion to our cause and determination for the people we serve.

Being the change meant doing things large and small to create real progress for Americans with mental illnesses and substance use disorders. It meant certifying a brand new Mental Health First Aider in Seattle and establishing the SAMHSA-HRSA Center for Integrated Health Solutions, to ensure that providers are able to meet the physical and mental health needs of our society's most vulnerable populations.

Being the change meant expanding and strengthening the healthcare workforce while training community psychiatrists and emerging leaders. It meant taking bold steps in advancing trauma-informed care and ensuring that our nation's veterans and military service members — those brave men and women to whom we owe so much — have access to community mental health and substance use services.

Most of all, being the change meant striving even further to help Americans and their elected officials understand the need for continued federal and state investment in mental health and substance use services.



Progress has been made, but being the change also means building on our gains and pressing ever forward.

And press forward we must. States are still reeling under the effects of the economic crisis. In Congress, proposals are under consideration to restructure Medicaid from a federal-state partnership into a block grant that would result in a total of \$750 billion in cuts to federal Medicaid spending over the next 10 years. The unfolding debt limit debate — particularly the question of whether and how deeply to cut entitlement programs — has a profound impact on Medicaid and other programs that fund safety net additions and mental health services.

In 2011, we must together stand strong, even in the face of continuing adversity. To be the change we want to see in the world means channeling the collective passion, energy, persistence, and perseverance of 1,950 organizations into action. It means our moving forward as one, and doing the most good we can each day in ways both large and small.

Speaking at the 41st National Council Conference in San Diego in May 2011, President Bill Clinton said, “We all have the capacity to do great things.” This is evident as we see our members in action every day. You remain our inspiration, giving us pride, purpose, and hope for a brighter future for those we serve.

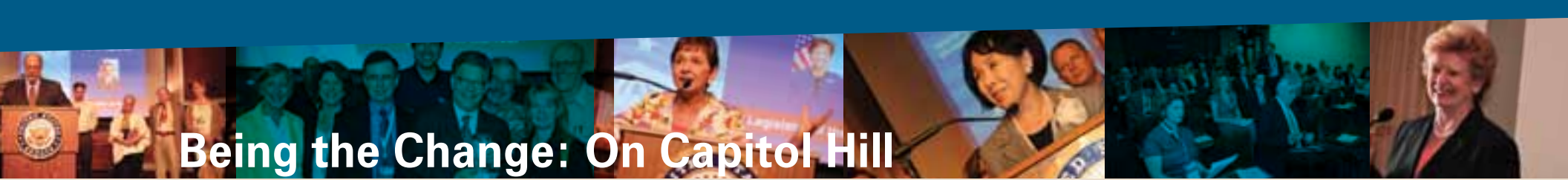

Being the Change: On Capitol Hill

Introducing the Health Information Technology for Behavioral Health Services Act to support an interconnected system of digital health records, critical to achieving greater coordination among substance use, mental health, and other healthcare providers, and to helping consumers manage their own care.

Championing the Excellence in Mental Health Act to establish Federally Qualified Behavioral Health Centers to increase access to Medicaid-supported community mental health and substance use treatment services for all Americans.

Ensuring passage of a six-month extension of enhanced federal Medicaid funding that helped states save jobs, preserve services, and prevent cuts during the economic crisis.

Supporting strict enforcement of the federal Mental Health Parity and Addiction Equity Act to ensure the end of discriminatory practices against mental health coverage by insurance companies.

Securing \$34 million in federal funds to support the co-location of behavioral health and primary care services in communities across the country to ensure that people are able to access general and specialty healthcare wherever it is most needed.

Demonstrating commitment, in the halls of Congress, to meeting the needs of the nation's most vulnerable populations, when nearly 500 behavioral healthcare providers, consumers, and community leaders gathered in Washington, DC for the National Council's 6th Annual Hill Day.

Supporting 6,290 caring citizens in sending 11,500 messages to their members of Congress to advocate for sustenance and support of the nation's behavioral health safety net.



Being the Change: In the Field

Serving as the nation's hub for expertise, technical assistance, and resources on primary and behavioral healthcare integration and wellness by establishing — on behalf of the federal government — the SAMHSA-HRSA Center for Integrated Health Solutions.

Preparing all safety net healthcare providers to meet the increased demand for services and to work within new payment and integrated service delivery structures as healthcare reform opens up access to behavioral healthcare for millions that go without it today.

Responding to the urgent need to ensure that all people who come into contact with the behavioral health system receive services sensitive to the impact of trauma through public education and a trauma-informed care learning community.

Equipping community providers with the tools and training to meet the growing demand for mental health and substance use services among returning Iraq and Afghanistan veterans so that those who risked their own lives to save others don't go without the care they desperately need.

Engineering dramatic improvements in community behavioral healthcare with the Access Redesign Initiative, which helps reduce wait times for treatment — from 6 months to on-demand — for thousands of consumers.

Introducing meaningful changes in the lives of persons with schizophrenia and helping them achieve independence in the community through the Advancing Standards of Care for Schizophrenia program.

Inspiring, educating, and connecting more than 3,000 healthcare leaders, professionals, and consumers through the 2011 National Council Conference, featuring President Bill Clinton and CMS Administrator Don Berwick.

Mentoring and coaching medical directors of community behavioral health organizations through the Psychiatric Leadership Program, now in its fourth year.

Nurturing a new generation of behavioral health leaders that reflects America's rapidly growing racial and ethnic minorities, through the Addressing Health Disparities Leadership Program.

Fostering excellence in management through a mini-MBA program — the Middle Management Academy — that has trained more than 1,500 up-and-coming healthcare leaders.

Diverting people with serious mental illness from the criminal justice system to community treatment and supporting re-entry into the community after incarceration.

Helping youth aged 16-25 years, struggling with emotional and behavioral difficulties, to achieve a positive life path through the Transition Age Youth Initiative.



Being the Change: In the Community

Supporting 1,950 member organizations — with a combined workforce of more than 250,000 people — to improve the quality of life in their communities through the delivery of essential mental health and addictions treatment and supports.

Spreading Mental Health First Aid to 20,000 caring citizens — from Congressional offices, public service, law enforcement, education, faith, human resources, healthcare, and many other sectors — to increase mental health literacy, enable early intervention, and offer help in crises.

Reaching more than 4,000,000 people through press coverage emphasizing that mental illnesses and addiction disorders are real, common, and treatable and need to be adequately supported.

Engaging thousands around the world in conversations about recovery from mental illness and substance use through Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, and the National Council’s website and mental healthcare reform blog.

Sharing best practices and success stories in recovery from substance use and mental illness with healthcare providers, consumers, funders, media, and policymakers through National Council Magazine, with themed issues on healthcare reform, integrated health, and workforce excellence.

Advancing awareness of critical issues in behavioral healthcare and fostering clinical and business skills through National Council Live webinars delivered to more than 15,000 professionals and stakeholders.

Honoring the best of the best — visionary leaders, members of Congress, consumers and family members, and community partners — through the Awards of Excellence, recognizing those who’ve worked to positively impact millions with mental illnesses and addiction disorders.

More than 6 million adults, children, and families throughout America are served by the public mental health and substance use treatment system. Many of them are eager to share their stories of recovery — whether in person or through the 900+ letters they wrote to members of Congress as part of the National Council for Community Behavioral Healthcare's annual Letter Writing Campaign. We are honored to share excerpts from these letters.

Dear Legislator,

I am writing today to share with you how important mental health and addictions treatment services are to me and my community. Please do everything you can in Washington to support community behavioral health centers and work hard to make sure that treatment services are fully funded.

My life before my emotional collapse was pretty exciting...from the time I was four, I knew that I wanted to act in theatre and I did from age 12 to 22...During my marriage I was a pastor's wife and served as Ohio state chairperson of the Friends of Child Fund. Following my divorce I returned to college to get my BA, finish my MA, and came within one hurdle of my PhD in history. Then shortly after beginning my dissertation

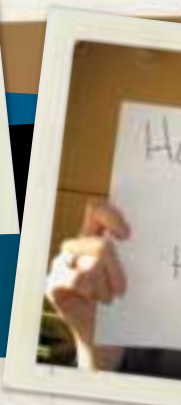
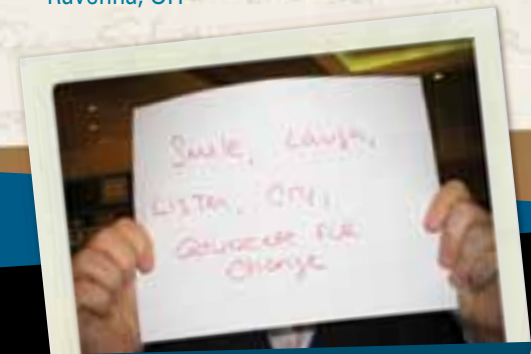
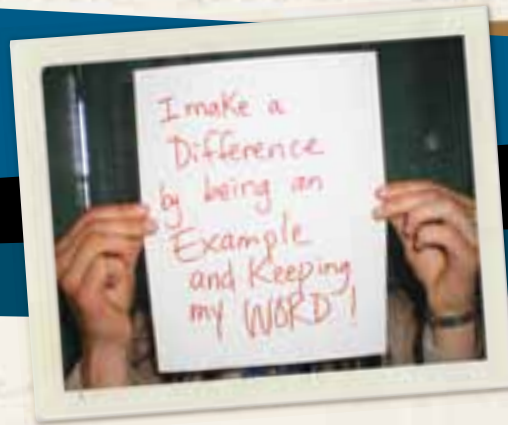
research, I hit a brick wall...I was working full time, attending college 2/3 time, raising my son through the teen years and taking care of my father who became progressively worse with dementia. During these years I also had four surgeries and should I say during those 11 years, I earned all As but B+ once. When my father died, I became a virtual vegetable.

Coleman Professional Services has literally saved my life. June 15, 1990 I came within a few moments of committing suicide then in 2000 I shut down completely. By then I found Coleman and so did not get as far as the bunk but I honestly believe that I would not be here if not for Coleman. I should also say I lost our family home of 36 years in the year after my father died. I found myself staring at walls day and night for 4 years, no housework, no laundry, no hygiene.

I have had crises since then and have used their emergency service at access. Until my Medicaid and SSD kicked in, they provided me with samples for medication. I have a therapist, a psychologist and attend two groups a week. Again, I would not be here without them. PLEASE continue to provide the funds for these programs.

I fight against stigma by being straightforward about my clinical depression and PTSD, regardless of others opinion. I also seek to destroy the misconception that intelligence cannot cohabitate with mental illness.

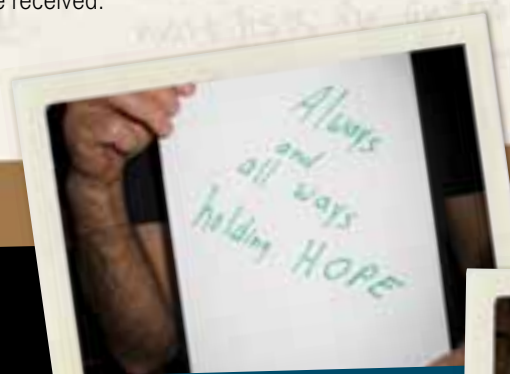

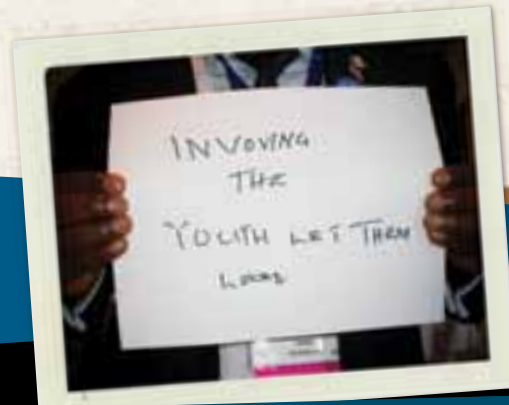
