§ Congress instructs SAMHSA to use \$12 million of this amount for discretionary grants to states for the purpose of expanding treatment services to individuals with opioid or heroin dependence. Funding may be used to support medication assisted treatment and other clinically appropriate services and must be available to states with the highest levels of need.
