Kathy has increased Centerstone's presence in the community by reaching out to gain partners within counties served. She is currently building and guiding a team of case managers and peer supports that are providing needed services to individuals and families – from helping them obtain substance treatment, access resources and enhance their life skills, to job placement and housing.

Kathy is involved in several action groups, including the Veterans Administration, local Veterans of Foreign Wars and American Legion and Illinois Department of Mental Health.
