



The U.S. has the highest maternal mortality rate among developed nations. And, while post-partum depression (PPD) affects 1 in 8 women in the U.S., women of color, particularly Black and African American women, consistently experience the greatest risk, but are less likely to receive access to equitable care due to challenges such as financial barriers, prejudice toward those experiencing mental health and substance use challenges, and a historical distrust of the health care system.
