

Successful Innovations in Workforce Retention (HR)

Rural, agricultural and tribal communities face a particular set of health inequities that are not as common in urban areas. Several factors including historical injustices, structural urbanism and the effects of the mental health and recovery services workforce shortage have disproportionately impacted access to health services in rural communities.

With the increased demand for mental health and substance use treatment services, but limited capacity in the mental wellbeing workforce in rural areas, providers and organizations in rural communities are getting creative and implementing ideas that leverage the many strengths of rural communities to improve their workforce related needs.
