

By creating a trauma-informed workplace, employers can help reduce the risk of retraumatization and support employees who have experienced trauma, ultimately improving employee wellbeing, increasing productivity and reducing turnover rates. It also promotes a positive and supportive organizational culture that values empathy, compassion and respect for all employees – and can lead to positive patient outcomes.
