





December: Needs Assessment



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January: Practice Transformation

- Recognize the CCBHC grant as a mechanism for organization transformation
- Identify change management strategies and tactics for CCBHC implementation
- Discuss approaches to integrate and align CCBHC with your organization's culture and strategic plan/mission/vision
- Consider elements of an effective communications plan for internal/external stakeholders



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February: Service Array

- SAMHSA has released an update to CCBHC draft criteria
- CCBHCs are required to provide and/or coordinate 9 distinct service types, each being person-centered, familycentered, developmentally, and culturally appropriate
- CCBHCs should engage in best practices that support completing the attestation.

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March: Staffing

- Use your resources and leverage peer/community health workers to share success stories as part of outreach and engagement efforts.
- Use of Cultural Brokers can support engagement with diverse populations as well as bridge gaps with western medical culture.





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April: Care Coordination

- CCBHCs provide a comprehensive set of services that are data driven and outcome focused.
- CCBHCs should develop care coordination KPIs and celebrate successes.
- Assess workflows and communication needs and develop/update accordingly.





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May: Partnerships

- There are key differences, and considerations, in DCO and care coordination/referral agreements.
- CCBHCs are required to coordinate care; agreements should outline expectations of the partnership.
- DCOs are an extension of the CCBHC and must uphold the same standards.

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June: Service Accessibility

- CCBHCs should develop partnerships with community partners to support outreach and engagement.
- CCBHCs are well positioned to provide chronic disease management, health education, and health promotion supports.
- Open access is one strategy for increasing access to services.

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July: Quality and Other Reporting

- Data should be used for more than just meeting reporting requirements; data should inform of CQI opportunities.
- CCBHCs can engage with community partners, such as hospitals/EDs, in collaborative CQI activities.
- Plan-Do-Study-Act is one approach to rapid cycle quality improvement.







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August: Sustainability

- CCBHCs need to be aware of their state's certification status as this will inform paths for sustainability.
- CCBHCs should understand total cost, revenue, and utilization of services to inform sustainability plan.
- Some CCBHCs may benefit from working with consults or developing financial expertise in house.


