





# CCBHC-E Care Coordination Learning Community

- **118** CCBHC-E clinics from **35** different states
- **8 sessions** in 5 months (*August – December 2022*)
- Organizational staff reached: **59,958 +**
- Clients reached: **291,100 +**
- **Topics** covered:
  - Implementing care coordination as part of CCBHC (how to implement; positions engaged)
  - The role of **health information technology**
  - **Partnering** with:
    - FQHCs, primary care, and specialty care
    - Emergency departments and hospitals
    - Law enforcement agencies; diversion from the criminal justice system
    - Community-based organizations; examining social determinants of health




