Overview of Practicum and Internship Experiences

Field placement courses (Practicum and Internship) span the entire duration of the academic semester (15 weeks). Students are expected to determine a schedule with their site supervisor prior to the start of the semester and be prepared to start at their placement site as early as the first week of the semester.

Practicum is the first experiential training component of field experience. The intention of practicum is to provide an opportunity for students to orient themselves to professional practice and begin working directly with clients/patients while under the supervision of a licensed practitioner.

Total hours: 100 (at least 40 of which are in direct client service)

Average weekly site hours: 6-8

Internships 1 and 2 are completed after the student has fulfilled the practicum requirements. The intention of internship is to build on the foundational experience of practicum and synthesize knowledge, skills and dispositions as a competent and confident counseling professional.

Minimum total hours for each Internship: 300 (at least 120 of which are in direct client service)

Average weekly site hours for each Internship: 19-20

Note: Recommended additional hours may vary, depending on state licensure/credentialing requirements.
