# WHAT IS MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID?

Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) is a worldwide educational program administered in the United States by the National Council for Mental Wellbeing. MHFA courses teach people how to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental and substance use issues. The training gives an individual the skills they need to reach out to provide initial help and support to someone who may be developing a mental health or substance use problem or experiencing a crisis.

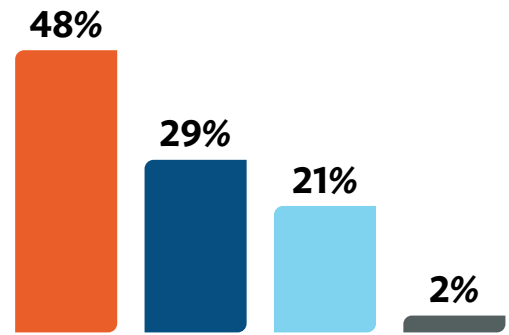
