Addressing the Behavioral Health Workforce Shortage

Based on the successful model founded by Kaiser Permanente, the CCBHC-Transformation (CCBHC-T) Workforce Career Accelerator expands access to mental health and substance use care by increasing the number of licensed clinicians, building capacity and expanding access to quality, community-responsive services. In this program, post-master's candidates receive up to \$8,500* in milestone-based incentives, including cash stipends and professional development.



Candidate Eligibility Requirements

- Holds a master's degree from an accredited program in counseling psychology, mental health counseling, marriage and family therapy, social work or substance use/addiction counseling, a Bachelor's Degree and pursuing CAADC, or a doctorate degree in clinical psychology (or will graduate by July 1, 2026)
- Is pursuing or is planning to pursue clinical licensure in social work, professional counseling, marriage and family therapy or substance use/addiction counseling, licensure in clinical psychology, or credentialing in substance use/addiction counseling
- Is committed to serving in community behavioral health settings
- Is employed full time by (or has an offer from) an eligible employment site in Illinois, Kansas or Michigan



Eligible Employment Sites

- CCBHCs or other state-approved community behavioral organizations, such as crisis providers, aspiring CCBHCs and rural behavioral health providers

*inclusive of Triad subscription valued at \$450

Up to \$8,500 in incentives

- Milestone-based incentives for licensure progress and completion
- Up to \$7,000 provided in cash stipends
- Up to \$1,500* provided in professional development benefits
